When Evil Seems to Prosper Roger Ellis, Lead Pastor

Esther 3 & 4, p.345

We live in a time of great political turmoil and unrest. In our frustration, we love to blame others for it (a political party, a "king" or a "queen," a nation, a people, an individual...). Certainly we live in a time when evil seems to prosper, much like the time of Esther.

1. When evil seems to prosper:

- a. An incredibly good deed goes unrewarded (Esther 2:21-22).
- b. An evil person is promoted to second in command (Esther 3:1).
- c. Revenge and ego drive the agenda (Esther 3:1-6).
- d. Rulers are easily manipulated (Esther 3:8-11).
- e. Those in power "do as they please" (Esther 3:11).
- f. Evil laws are passed (Esther 3:12-14 & 1:19).
 - g. Rulers are smug and the people are confused (Esther 3:15).
 - h. The righteous tend to remain silent, hopeless and powerless (Esther 4:3, 11, 14).

NEXT**STEPS**

- O Memorize Esther 4:14.
- O Once again, read the story of Esther.
- O Fast and pray once this week.
- O Go public for Jesus through believer's baptism on August 30.

DISCOVERY QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY OR GROUP DISCUSSION

Check-In: Since we last met, how did your "I will..." and sharing go?

- 1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing? How can we help? Do you know anyone who needs help at this time?
- 2. Read Esther 3:8-11 & 4:10-17 together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
- 3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
- 4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (Aim for a specific: **"I will..."** next step.)
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you want to **share with**.)

- b. He has set the clock (Esther 4:14, 3:7-12).
- c. He is exposing His people (Esther 3:4-9, 7:1-6).
- d. He is asking His people to risk it all (Esther 4:11-16).
- e. He is driving His people to prayer (Esther 4:3, 16).
- f. He is working out His plan (Esther 4:14).
