JESUS IS BURIED

Jesus is dead.

A rich man named Joseph, and Nicodemus, both secretly disciples of Jesus, take His body from the cross. They wrapped Jesus' body in a clean, linen cloth and placed it in Joseph's own new tomb cut out of rock. They rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away.

The religious leaders were afraid someone would come and steal Jesus' body, so they asked Pilate to seal the tomb and post guards. (John 19:38-42 / Matthew 27:57-66)

TASK

What was happening? Where was Jesus' body?

TASK

- Choose one person in your group to stand behind the white box.
- Everyone else can stand on the other side of the box—able to see the contents.
- Using only words, the team must guide the person to choose the envelope inside the box with the letter "Z" on it.
- When the person finds the correct envelope, they can open it and read the next clue.
