

When Jesus came back to life after dying on the cross, it was the greatest escape of all time. Jesus conquered death! Jesus' death and resurrection defeated Satan just like God promised in Genesis 3:15.

Let's Escape the Tomb with Jesus! Read the story, follow the clues and complete the tasks. Together, you can Escape the Tomb!

- 1. Gather supplies from Supply List
- 2. Print CLUE CARDS and ENVELOPE LABELS
- 3. Place CLUE CARD LABELS on envelopes and insert the appropriate CLUE CARDS
  - a. Don't forget to include the additional pieces—MAZE / BIBLE VERSE PUZZLE PIECES\* / ANGEL MESSAGE CODE SHEE
    - b. BIBLE VERSE PUZZLE needs to be cut out prior to placement in envelope
- 4. Attach CLUE CARD inside Toilet Paper tube with tape
- 5. Put DECOY LABELS on remaining envelopes.
  - a. Place "J" "W" and "K" decoy envelopes in the EMPTY BOX (see next instructions)
  - b. Place TAX COLLECTOR, TARP, "F" AND "I" decoy envelopes in container with all of the other available envelopes
  - c. NOTE: Decoy envelopes are empty. If a student chooses one and looks inside they will realize they need to choose a different envelope
- 6. Assemble box. Attach EMPTY BOX envelope to the outside of box. Place Envelope "Z" inside box along with three decoy envelopes.
  - a. See note above about decoy envelopes
- 7. Create popsicle stick clue
  - a. Using a marker, write D-O-U-B-T-I-N-G along the top of sticks (one letter on the top of each stick)
  - b. Write O-P-E-N in the middle on 4 separate sticks
  - c. Write E-N-V-E-L-O-P-E, ¾ of the way down, 1 letter on each of the 8 sticks
  - d. Write D on the last stick, lower right corner
- 8. Write F-I-N-A-L-! on the bottom of the paper cups—1 letter on each cup





- 9. Insert final clue in the Colorful Envelope
- 10. When you have everything assembled and ready to go, place on a table in room
- 11. 11. Ready. Set. Start with the first envelope. Go! Escape the Tomb!
