## DIRECTIONS:

1. Using the apple slicer, cut the apple into 8 pieces.
2. Cut the cheese slice so it fits on top of one of the apple slices.
3. Cut the Fruit by the Foot into a small square "sail."
4. Place one apple slice on your plate.
5. Place a slice of cheese on top of the apple slice.
6. Using a toothpick, put it through the top and bottom of the Fruit by the Foot "sail."
7. Stick the toothpick and sail into the apple/cheese boat base.
8. You have your sailboat! Enjoy!
