Our Statement of Faith has a flow to it. It demands a resolution to the story, to history.

1. There is overwhelming biblical support for Christ's return.

2. Christ's return will be personal, bodily,	
and glorious (Matthew 24:29-31; Acts 1:1-11; Revelation 1:7-8).	
3. Christ's return will be literal 1,000 year reign on the earth (Revelation 20:1-10	
4. Christ's return will be a time of great (Revelation 19; Colossians 3:4).	
5. The exact time of Christ's return is not for us to know (Matthew 24:3, 36; Acts 1:6-7).	
6. The delay of Christ's return should cause us to than scoff (2 Peter 3:3-9).	rather
7. The anticipation of Christ's return purifies the way we (1 John 3:1-3; Titus 2:11-14).	live
8. Our world is unwittingly for (Romans 8:19-25).	Christ's return

DISCOVERY QUESTIONSFOR FAMILY OR GROUP DISCUSSION
