

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Give each child a sheet of paper and a pencil.
- 2. Have each child write their name on the back of the paper.
- 3. Listening to the leader, draw the "part" of a dad that the leader says.
- 4. When you've finished drawing that part, put your pencil down and pass your paper to the person on your right. (If you're at the end of a row, a leader will take it to the person across the aisle.)
- 5. Keep following the same instructions until all "parts" of a dad are drawn.
- 6. Leaders will be sure to bring papers back to original owners.
- 7. What does your dad look like?

PARTS OF DAD FOR KIDS TO DRAW:

- Draw a dad's face
- Draw a dad's shirt for that face.
- Draw a dad's pants/shorts for the body.
- Draw a dad's shoes or feet.
- Draw a dad's hands and arms if need be.
- Draw a dad's hair or hat.
- Draw a dad's tie or bow tie.
- · Draw one object a dad carries with him in his hand.
