Don't Forget

Deuteronomy 8:11, p.127

Holidays are essentially designed to help us remember. There are family holidays better known as anniversaries and birthdays. There are national holidays like Memorial Day and Independence Day. There are religious holidays like Christmas and Easter. Even God gave His people annual holidays like Passover and the Day of Atonement, specifically designed to help His people to "Be careful...do not forget the Lord your God." How could anyone forget God?

As incredible as it may seem:

- 1. Our tendency is to *neglect* our God.
- 2. Our tendency is to relax our diligence for God.
- 3. Our tendency is to take things from God for granted.
- 4. Our tendency is to view a test as evidence of God's *absence*.

Signs of Neglect:

- Ino longer treat Jesus with respect.
- 'I am no longer in awe of what Jesus has done to rescue me.
- I am bored with the Word of God.
- I find it difficult to celebrate and praise Him with my own lips.
- * <u>I obey, pray, serve, give...out of obligation/show</u> rather than out of love.

THE **ONE THING:** "Diligence causes us to remember." or "Neglect causes us to forget."
