1 Timothy 1, p. 829

We are those who have been entrusted (1 Timothy 1:11 & 6:20; 2 Timothy 1:14 & 2:2) with the gospel. Our game plan, just like a football team with a football, is to: protect it; run with it, pass it, distribute it and advance it... together. In order for us to be successful as a team, we need to be reminded of the following game plan:

1. Start with the *basics* (<u>1 Timothy 1:1-2</u>).

2. Anticipate opposition (<u>1 Timothy 1:3-11</u>, <u>18-20</u>)

3. Expect life transformation (1 Timothy 1:12-16).

NEXT**STEPS**

- O Memorize <u>1 Timothy 6:20a.</u>
- O Read <u>1 Timothy</u> this week, personalizing it (as if written to you and as if written by you).
- O Ask God for opportunities to simply share the gospel.
- O Google "The Bible Project: 1 Timothy."

DISCOVERY QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY OR GROUP DISCUSSION

Check-In: Since we last met, how did your "I will..." and sharing go?

- 1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing? Do you know anyone who needs help at this time? As a group, how can we help?
- 2. Read **<u>1 TIMOTHY 1:12-20.</u>** together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
- 3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
- 4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (Share a specific: "I will...")
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you plan to **share with**.)
