1 Timothy 6:11-21, p. 831

We have always lived in uncertain times. We live in a society that is driven by discontent, greed, godlessness, autonomy, idolatry, factions, endless disputes and an intentional dismissal of the Word of God. That's how it was in Timothy's day too. In light of this context, Paul commands Timothy and us regarding how we are to live our lives.

How are the people of God to live?

1.	We are to be those who fight the goo	d fight
(<u>1</u>	Timothy 6:11-12).	

2. We are to be those who make the good confession (1 Timothy 6:12-16).

3. We are to be those who do what is **good for eternity** (1 Timothy 6:17-21).
