<u>Luke 2:25-38, p. 716</u>

As we rehearse the birth of Jesus Christ each December we can't help but notice that God uses people -- those considered insignificant by the world --Mary, Joseph and the shepherds. Too often, however, our Christmas journey ends with Luke 2:20. If we travel a bit further we will meet two remarkable senior adults who show us how to glorify God today, just like they did.

## **DISCOVERY QUESTIONS** FOR FAMILY OR GROUP DISCUSSION

Check-In: Since we last met, how did your "I will..." and sharing go?

- 1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing? Do you know anyone who needs help at this time? As a group, how can we help?
- 2. Read <u>Matthew 2:18-24</u>. together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
- 3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
- If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (Share a specific: "I will...")
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you plan to **share with**.)
