John 4:1-38

Jesus stops at Jacob's well in Samaria at noon on his journey to Galilee. The disciples head to town to pick up lunch. A Samaritan woman comes to the well and has an encounter with Jesus that changes everything! She discovers living water!

Jesus did not have to go through Samaria, but He MUST! 1.

He was deconstructing/demolishing walls of bigotry.

- 2. As long as you have some religion, and practice it *sincerely*, you are okay.

Christianity is exclusively all *inclusive*!

The Messiah is the Great *Explainer*. 3.

"He will explain everything to us." John 4:25

He is the Great Transformer!

Focusing your life on your **belly** will cause you to miss the greatest feast of all.

- Let the Holy Spirit expose your *bigotry*. 1.
- Let the Messiah be the **TRANSFORMER** God intended! 2.
- Feed on the real *food* that WILL give life! 3.
