Love Washes Feet

John 13:1-17

Today we consider the Last Supper as recorded by John. It looks very different than the other gospels. There is this dramatic scene of Jesus washing the disciples' feet. Jesus was deconstructing their notions about leadership, and reconstructing a servant attitude.

Deconstruct: Death is the *end*.

Reconstruct: Death is a *departure*.

Deconstruct: God will love you as long as you *keep* your *nose clean*.

Reconstruct: *Nothing* separates us from His *love*.

Deconstruct: *Servants* wash feet.

Reconstruct: *Servant/Leaders* wash feet.

Deconstruct: The *letter* of the law allures us.

Reconstruct: The *intention* of the law frees us.
