

Today we consider the Last Supper as recorded by John. It looks very different than the other gospels. There is this dramatic scene of Jesus washing the disciples' feet. Jesus was deconstructing their notions about leadership, and reconstructing a servant attitude.

Deconstruct: Death is the end.

Reconstruct: Death is a *departure*.

Deconstruct: God will love you as long as you keep your nose clean.

Reconstruct: Nothing separates us from His love.

Deconstruct: Servants wash feet.

Reconstruct: Servant/Leaders wash feet.

Deconstruct: The *letter* of the law allures us.

Reconstruct: The intention of the law frees us.


