1. God exists and He has spoken? (1:1)
2. God has spoken to us through His Son? (1:2)
3. Jesus is the chosen one? (1:2)
4. Jesus is the creator of the universe? (1:2)
5. Jesus is God in the flesh? (1:3)
6. Jesus is the sustainer of the universe? (1:3)
7. Jesus is the rescuer of mankind? (1:3)
8. Jesus has everything figured out? (1:3)
9. Jesus is superior to angels? (1:4-14)
10. we are granted great worth and dignity by God? (2:5-16)
11. Jesus accomplished everything He set out to do for us? (2:17-18)

NOTES FOR PERSONAL & SMALL GROUP STUDY

1 KEEPING IT REAL

Jesus asked Peter: Who do you say I am? (Matthew 16:16)
How would you answer in your own words?

2 LOOK AT THE BOOK

What do you learn about Jesus in the following passages:
Colossians: 1:15-20, Philippians 2:5-10, John 1:1-5, 14, Hebrews 1:3.
How does this expand the way you usually think of Jesus?

3 Consider John 15:15 in light of Who Jesus is. How does this fit with how Jesus is portrayed in the verses above? How does friendship with Jesus compare with other friendships?

4 TAKING IT FURTHER

Jesus asked Martha: Do you believe this? (John 11:26) Reread the passages above savoring the idea that Jesus calls you His friend. Too good to be true? How would you respond to Jesus' question?
