A Life of Sacrifice Roger Ellis, Lead Pastor 2 Samuel 24, p.227 1 Chronicles 21, p.291

The key point: "I will not sacrifice to the LORD my God burnt offerings that cost me nothing."

Followers of Christ are called to live lives of sacrifice to Him (Romans 12:1).

Please take note of the place that David purchased:

- God told David to build an altar and sacrifice to Him on this site (2 Samuel 24:18 & 1 Chronicles 21:18)
- 2. Solomon built the temple of the LORD on this site known as

Mount Moriah (2 Chronicles 3:1-2)

- Abraham was told to sacrifice Isaac in the region of Moriah (Genesis 22)
- 4. **Jesus is crucified** just outside the city of Jerusalem (Hebrews 13:11-12)
