**NOTES FOR PERSONAL & SMALL GROUP STUDY**

**KEEPING IT REAL**

**1** "Mine!" One of the first words we learn and love to use. How do your home, your car, your family, your abilities or accomplishments make you feel?

**LOOK AT THE BOOK**

**2** Read 1 Chronicles 29:10-13. What things belong to God? Why? How does this expand your view of God? How might it change your view of the things that are yours?

**3** Read Romans 11:33-36. What do you learn about God? Restate verse 33 in your own words. What is the answer to the 3 questions asking "Who...?" Why is that the answer? What does it mean that all things are from, through and to God? How might your relationship to God grow as you embrace these truths more fully?

**TAKING IT FURTHER**

**4** As children of our Father and co-heirs with our Savior, Jesus, it is easy to forget that God is so much more than that (Father & Savior). Spend some time alone, or with your small group, praising and thanking God for Who He is.
