

My participation in the chase (Matthew 6:33) declares my understanding of kingdom values:

- My participation in the chase declares the value I place upon the <u>Word of God</u> (Matthew 13:1-23).
- My participation in the chase declares that <u>the end</u> is more important than <u>the beginning</u> (Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43, 47-50)

- 4. My participation in the chase declares I refuse to give up when **nothing appears to be happening** (Matthew 13:33-34)
- My participation in the chase declares <u>God's value</u> to me (Matthew 13:44).
- 6. My participation in the chase declares **my value to God** (Matthew 13:45-46)
