1 What tends to determine how you feel about things other people ask you to do?

LOOK AT THE BOOK

2 Paul uses the term "fear and trembling" four times (1 Corinthians 2:3, 2 Corinthians 7:15, Ephesians 6:5, and Philippians 2:12). Discuss the fear and trembling of believers as Paul uses the terms.

3 Paul tells us in Philippians 2:13 that God gives us both the desire and the ability to do His will. How do we sort out which desires God places in our heart and which are of our own making?

4 What desires are you feeling in terms of serving the Lord more effectively? Ask the Holy Spirit for guidance on how to understand and act on those desires.
