KEEPING IT REAL

LOOK AT THE BOOK

- Paul reminds Gentile believers (Romans 11:17-18) that they were graciously grafted in to partake of the rich root of the olive tree. Discuss Paul's analogy of the natural branches and the wild branches of the olive tree.
- The Church began as a Jewish institution. Acts 15 describes the first church council, in which Paul, James and other Jewish believers addressed the requirements for Gentiles to be followers of Jesus. In the centuries that followed, the church came to be understood as a Gentile institution. What were some of the devastating consequences of that turnabout?
