- Read Matthew 20:24-28. What is Jesus contrasting here? How does Jesus say one is to be considered the greatest in heaven? How do the rulers of the Gentiles exercise their authority? Read John 13:12-17. What does this passage say to us? How will you apply it in your life?

#### **TAKING IT FURTHER**

While we might prefer to be the queen, prince, or king, Jesus says we are to be like Him in service! How will we embrace the attitude demonstrated in Jesus' earthly ministry? How, specifically, will you be a servant of all, as Jesus was?
