NOTES FOR PERSONAL & GROUP STUDY

KEEPING IT REAL

- 1 Describe the glorious commendations the world has to offer—perhaps a Nobel Prize, the Congressional Medal of Honor, a Super Bowl MVP, an Oscar or a Grammy, etc.—and the degree of fulfillment they convey to the recipients.

LOOK AT THE BOOK

- 2 Discuss Isaiah 48:1-11 in terms of how the Lord demonstrates He is worthy of all glory and honor.
- 3 In Revelation 5, John describes a scene in Heaven's throne room. The attendants proclaim the Lamb's worthiness (v. 9, 12), and proclaim blessing, honor, glory and dominion (v. 13). Discuss the reasons for that worthiness identified in chapter 5.

- 4 Identify three ways in which the Lord has glorified Himself in your life that you might be able to share with others.
