What Does It Matter?

In an <u>era</u> of permissiveness, how can I <u>pursue</u> what is <u>right</u>?

Three Key Observations from Jeremiah 32:

1. Decide to be **counter - cultural** . (vs. 1-2)

- 2. Keep your eyes on the **Lord**, not the **enemy**. (vs. 6-10)
- 3. Be willing to **go all in** . (vs. 11-15)

You can do what doesn't make sense \underline{today} because of your \underline{faith} in the God who holds $\underline{tomorrow}$.

O Sovereign Lord!
You made the heavens and the earth
by your strong hand and your powerful arm.
Nothing is too hard for You.
You see the enemy I am facing—
Even so, help me to do all
that you have asked me to do.
