WHAT DO YOU WANT TO DO WHEN YOU GROW UP?

In our Bible lesson today, we're going to lean that God had a special plan for Peter's life—a plan that was completely different than anything Peter had imagined.

How about you? Have you thought about what you want to do when you grow up? Let's see what you are thinking about!

SUPPLIES:

- 1 piece of cardstock with the shape of a person drawn on it
- pen, pencil or markers for drawing

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Have each student fill in the drawing of the person with whatever is necessary to show what he/she wants to do or be when they grow up. Give as much detail as possible in the time given.
- 2. If a student isn't sure what they want to do/be here are some ideas:

Doctor / teacher / athlete / pastor / president / librarian Nurse / fire fighter / pilot / meteorologist / actor / police officer

- 3. Allow 5 minutes for drawing.
- 4. Have students share their drawing. Can anyone guess who they want to be?

DISCUSSION:

Just like God had a special plan for Peter, He has a special plan for you, too! Ephesians 2:10 says, "we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago."



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
